As in " I would not be surprised if it rains today". Can it be used when one is trying to be polite or to make a compliment? A: This is an interesting case. I don't think "I would not be surprised if it rains today" is an example of politeness in English. Here are a couple others: My native dialect of English has a verb phrase "lie in wait for", meaning to wait and be prepared. All the people around us are in a crowded space and looking at a surveillance camera, so we should not say anything that could incriminate us. The verb "would" is often used in English without any context or with context of possible outcomes. This is a colloquial, conversational language, and it is therefore not exactly polite. To show politeness, use the colloquial expression "wouldn't" or a colloquial verb with non-colloquial meaning. P.S. I would not be surprised if it rains today. A: It is not appropriate to state "I would not be surprised if" in polite, professional or social conversations. It is a common phrase, but it is not the right one to use in all situations. This phrase is often used as an expression of surprise at something, for instance, "I would not be surprised if he got there early" or "I would not be surprised if you opened the door". If you want to say that you would not be surprised, use "I am not surprised" or "I am not expecting anything like this to happen." If you want to say that you would be surprised, use "I would be surprised if...." or "I would be amazed if..." Example: I would not be surprised if it rains today. I am c6a93da74d
